In compliance with RSA 41:14-a, the East Kingston Board of Selectmen shall hold public hearings on September 14, 2026 and September 21, 2026 to solicit comments regarding the proposed acceptance of a gift of a 12-acre parcel identified as the Henshaw Lot #4 located at the end of Robin Lane. A vote shall take place no sooner than 7 days or later than 14 days after the second public hearing is held. This is hearing number two.

Board Members present: Joseph Cacciatore – Chairman, Matthew Freeman and Edward Warren.

Others Present: Town Administrator Grace Ruelle and Conservation Commission member Vicki Brown.

Mr. Cacciatore opened the public hearing at 6:00 pm with the roll call. He announced this was the second of two public hearings necessary for the board to consider accepting this land gift.

He opened the floor to questions or comments from board members. There were none.

Conservation Commission member Vicki Brown stated she had no additional information to provide since the last hearing but was willing to field questions from the board should they have any.

Although there were no further questions or comments, Chairman Cacciatore kept the public hearing open for ten additional minutes to allow for the possibility of late arrivals to the hearing. There were no other arrivals.

It was also noted that official board action on this gift (donation) of land would take place at the board's next regularly scheduled meeting on September 28, 2026. That meeting begins at 6:30pm and will be held at the Pound School.

MOTION: Chairman Cacciatore motioned to close the public hearing; seconded by Mr. Freeman. The motion passed 3-0-0 and the meeting ended at 6:10pm.
