The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment pursuant to NH RSA 31:95-b regarding accepting and expending unanticipated revenues from the Opioid Abatement Community Grant for supporting Littleton Fire Rescue's Mobile Integrated Healthcare Program (MIH) in the amount of \$150,000 and a second one from NH Department of Homeland Security & Emergency Management (HSEM) with a 4740 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) in the amount of \$1,455,820 for the repair and replacement of the Manns Hill Road Culvert Project.
