Some additional cleanup trimming will still be needed. The Conservation Commission looked at some example kiosk types and voted on their preferred choice. The plan is to have some signage up this fall.

New Business - Member Leonida Rasenas volunteered to set up a table for Old Home Day representing the Salisbury Conservation Commission which will showcase conservation happenings around town and have handouts and cards from NH Fish & Game along with other interesting conservation information. She would like to do photo opportunities with large cardboard cutouts. She would like to purchase a Sasquatch and a black bear cutout. **Member Kathleen Doyle motioned to spend \$100 of Salisbury Conservation Commission money to purchase a cutout or two for Old Home Day. Member Dave Kelly seconded that motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.**

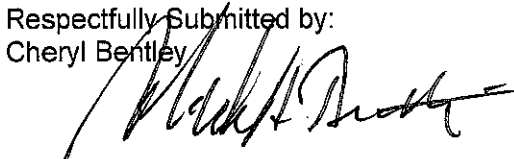
