CONSERVATION COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES**

Tuesday, April 21, 2026

April Sargent called the meeting to order at 4:00

Only three members in attendance, no quorum established.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: March 10, 2026 minutes were deferred until next meeting

MAIL CHECK: April Sargent reviewed the mail received with those present which included NH Turtle Rescue, NHDES permits and requests for more information, GCCD annual meeting invitation and the Timber Crier

OLD ITEMS:

1. Trails – No feedback on Easter Egg Hunt event. A. Packard said we needed 60 blazes for the Pilotte property and that she ran into someone who claims to be “maintaining” the Herd Trail. A. Packard advised that it is not a trail on the town’s property, also to cover the existing blazes with colored plexiglass panels. A. Sargent stated that the Holderness School did a clean-up at the Pemi – Oxbow property and someone cut the overgrown area before the bridge. Will try and find out who to thank them.
2. Discussed recent legislation of concern to commission members regarding Habitat Corridors, on-line

NEW ITEMS:

1. Looking to schedule an annual stakeholder meeting with the Oxbow people in May later in the month in lieu of regular meeting of the CC. A. Sargent to do Doodle poll and will let all know time, date and location.
2. A. Sargent will discuss this year’s monitoring assignments with full quorum but recommending no change.
