MINUTES OF PUBLIC MEETING

Tuesday August 11, 2026

Town Hall – Main Room

6:30 PM

Select Board members present: George Willard, Ken Caisse and Clayton Lennartz

Other Attendees: Julie McAdoo, Nick Rowe, Vivian Wills

Meeting called to order by Caisse at 6:30 PM.

Chairman Comments: *None*

Public Comment: *None*

Old Business:

1. **Update on complaint – Hudson Rd. – Rowe:** - *No update*
2. **Safety Committee – No Update**
3. **Review and approve Building application (if completed) – Rowe-Hill Rd.** – *Rowe mentioned he is still working with the NHDES, and he will also wait until the driveway is ready before he submits anything else.*

New Business:

- **Rec Dept events & update** – *Wills mentioned the homeschool group would like to use the town hall to have monthly meeting meet and greets. Caisse noted someone from the Rec dept should be there, or they can do it on their own by completing a reservation form and we can waive the fee. Wills stated they will continue with the rec sponsoring it for now. Wills also mentioned there is a girls softball league that would like to use our ballfield and the rec department supports this and has completed a reservation form. Games will go through November 1st. Wills also discussed a 250th celebration they are planning for the 22nd of August. The board signed the paperwork and the Rec. Dept will now need to obtain the additional required signatures. Wills also noted they found some mugs and hats from the towns 250th celebration years ago, and they would like to sell them on the 22nd or even at the Harvest festival. Since these items have been abandoned for quite some time, Lennartz moved to donate these abandoned items to the recreation department to do whatever they want with them. Willard seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.*
- **250 Dept Anniversary Committee recommendations:-** *McAdoo presented an award recommendation that was approved by the 250th Anniversary committee. The recommendation is for the Temple Volunteer Fire Department Firefighter fund for the purchase of a Bose sound system to be used for any town event. The amount they are awarding will be \$2,000 towards the total cost. Willard moved to approve the award of \$2,000 towards the cost of the Bose system. Lennartz seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.*

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- **Review request for ½ payment upfront Lizzies Garage Highway barn:** -Caisse stated that Lizzie's Garage doors wants ½ down payment before ordering the garage doors for the new highway barn. Caisse noted we do not usually do this, and the amount would be \$8,350 and it will then take 4 weeks to install the doors. We will then be billed the second half once installed. Lennartz moved to approve the down payment of \$8,350. Caisse seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion passed.
- **Sign Trustees letter to the TF – Highway barn:** Caisse moved to authorize the transfer \$19,063.60 from the Highway Garage Maintenance Repair and Construction Expendable Trust Fund to the General fund for the Hamshaw lumber invoice and the ½ down payment from Lizzie's garage doors. Lennartz seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion passed.
- **Change candidate night –** Postponed until August 25th when Phil Lauriat can attend.
- **Sign Solar tax credit –** Caisse noted that Avitar has approved the credit for tax year 2027. Caisse moved to sign the application. Willard seconded, Lennartz abstained, motion passed.
- **Sign Occupancy permit Corliss – 220 Webster –** Caisse noted he has done the inspection and therefore moved to sign the paperwork. Lennartz seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.
- **Approve Select Board Meeting Minutes July 28, 2026:** Willard moved to approve the meeting minutes from June 28, 2026 as written. Lennartz seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.

Committee Updates:

- **Police Board** – Caisse noted they recently purchased 9 tires from detail funds. Caisse also mentioned they added an old officer as a matron for female officers.
- **Conservation Commission:** Caisse noted the Barry orchard is on their next agenda. Lennartz noted he will be attending that meeting and will update the board.

Other Business:

- **Building permit – Cottage- Jeta Grove:** Caisse noted they are waiting for approval from the health inspector. Willard moved to approve the application pending the health inspectors approval. Lennartz seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.
- **Building permit – Lucyniak:** Caisse noted this is a sealing up of some crawl space in the basement. Willard moved to approve the application, Lennartz seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.
- **Occupancy permit Hughes Barn/Garage/ADU:** Caisse noted he has done the inspection and therefore moved to sign the paperwork. Lennartz seconded, all were in favor, motion passed.
